**Sales Tax Holiday** + On July 7<sup>th</sup> a Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday was signed into law. The tax holiday will begin August 6 and last through August 15, 2010. During this window, state taxes on clothing and school supplies will be reduced by 5% to 1.25% (instead of 6.25%). Other Local County and City taxes will still apply. Please see the attachment.

**Physical Exams, Immunizations, and Birth Certificates +** Illinois Public Act 095-0671 mandates that all new ZLS students, Kindergarteners, and 5<sup>th</sup> graders show proof of a current **physical examination**. All Kindergarten students and students entering school in IL for the first time are required to have an **eye examination** before Oct. 15. Students entering Kindergarten, Second Grade, and Sixth Grade must present proof of a **dental examination** before May 15. A **certified birth certificate**, displaying a county seal, and current **immunization records** must be on file for all students.
